



Pets on Trails



At the Fort Kent Outdoor Center, we realize that pets are important family members for many of us and enjoying the outdoors together is fun and healthy for all. We also realize that not everyone is comfortable around pets and may feel threatened. With that in mind, we have developed guidelines for Pets on Trails for both winter and summer use.

Winter Use

We have designated three ski trails as Pet Friendly. These are **Volunteer Way**, **Mickey's Way** and the **Acadian Loop**. These trails can be accessed from the FKOC trailhead or the Red Barn trailhead. These trails are marked with Dog Decals at each starting point.

Pets are welcome on all snowshoe trails.

Please observe the following:

- 🐾 During peak trail use, Saturdays and Sundays 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM daily, please do not bring your pet on the trails. All other days and times are wide open (except during scheduled events);
- 🐾 Pets must be under your control at all times;
- 🐾 Be prepared to clean up after your pet.

Summer Use

The ski trails are used by members during the summer for walking, running, biking and roller-skiing. Pets are welcome on all trails, but we ask that pets use the unpaved trails as much as possible to minimize conflicts with other users.

Pets are welcome on all days and at all times (except during scheduled events);

Please observe the following:

- 🐾 Pets must be on a leash and under your control at all times;
- 🐾 Be prepared to clean up after your pet.
