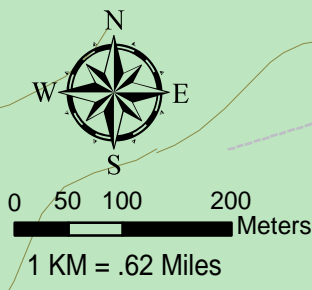


Nordic Trail Map
